- If there is anything that you would like to see changed?

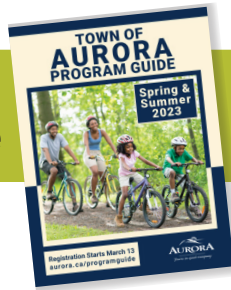
This is a drop-in event that will feature information displays, feedback stations, and an opportunity to discuss the Draft Master Plan with the project team.

The final Parks and Recreation Master Plan is scheduled to be presented to Town of Aurora General Committee on **June 6, 2023**.

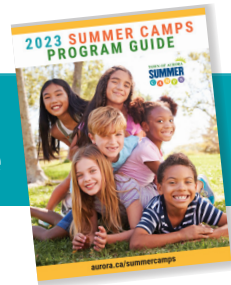
