

## **Proclamation**

## **World Sickle Cell Awareness Day**

June 19, 2024

**Whereas** the World Health Organization (2006), the United Nations (2008) and the Government of Ontario (2021) have recognized Sickle Cell Disease (SCD) as a global and local public health priority and to raise awareness, and designated the 19th day of June every year as World Sickle Cell Day (WSCD); and

**Whereas** the Sickle Cell Awareness Group of Ontario (SCAGO) recognizes SCD as an increasingly important medical issue in the province; and

**Whereas** out of the estimated 6,500 Canadians affected by SCD, 3,500 live in Ontario; and

**Whereas** over 65% of babies born with the disease nationally are born in the province of Ontario; and

**Whereas** through education and awareness programs, SCAGO is doing its part to reduce the stigma and discrimination faced by the families with children, youth and adults living with Sickle Cell Disease;

Therefore be it resolved that, on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Aurora, I, Mayor Tom Mrakas, do hereby proclaim the day of **June 19, 2024 as World Sickle Cell** Awareness Day in the Town of Aurora.
